

SPECIAL KOREAN WAR 60TH ANNIVERSARY KWVA PEACE CAMP FOR YOUTH TOUR 19 - 26 JULY 2010

With the 60th Anniversaries of the Korea War upon us, the Korean government has made major decisions to commemorate, not only the veterans and their contributions to saving their country from Communism, but to **Welcome** our Grandchildren to Korea on a very special program in July 2010. Called "**Peace Camp for Youth**", this program was tested by Canada last year and we have received glowing reports on how successful it was.

General information & requirements:

- * Grand Children of Korean War Veteran * Be at least eighteen (18) years old.
 - * Be in "relatively" good health since some physical hiking/walking involved.
 - * Have a current passport.
 - * Tour Date: **19 - 26 July 2010.**
 - * Approximately twenty-five (25) in the group.
 - * The departure city will be Los Angeles, California.
 - * Yes, parents/relatives (no "friends") can accompany the child, but they will be required to pay full fare.
 - * **All expense's for the grandchild** while in Korea, will be paid for by the ROK government. (Double occupancy)
- Tour participant's will be required to pay 1/2 his/her air fare. (Which will be "approximately" \$800.00 from LAX).



* A service of charge of \$400.00 is required for administrative handling, American adult escorts, ticketing, health and disability insurance (required by the ROK government). **Note:** Insurance is vital since the ROK government will not be responsible for any losses or damage to personal items, medical expense's, injuries or loss of life due to accidents while in Korea.

* All programs are conducted in English.
